Our nation's most decorated battleship, serving in World War II, Korea, Vietnam and the Persian Gulf War. The Battleship New Jersey is 45,000-tons of living history! Nearly three football fields long (887-feet) and over 11 stories high, it's the longest battleship ever built!

- *LOUD & PROUD!!!!!!*

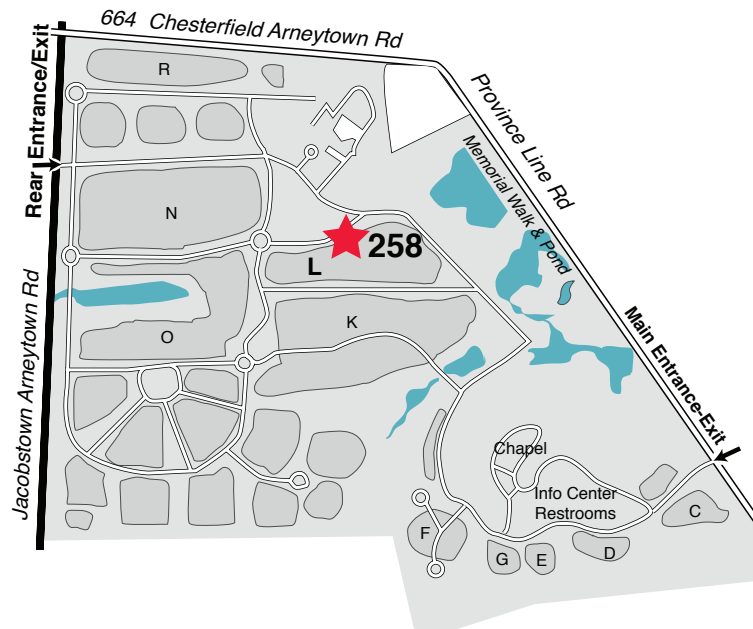


SCOUT FLAG PLACEMENT CEREMONY
